Re: Town Foreman's Report

**Water Treatment Plant** – The distribution lines in the water treatment plant are wearing out and need to be replaced. The Town Foreman asked three companies for quotes to replace – currently waiting for one more quote to come in. The pipes are leaking and cannot be repaired; it is imperative that they be replaced immediately.

**Ramm Avenue East** has deteriorated beyond repair. A short term fix would be to use a track hoe and install material for new road base. This would be a temporary fix until the parking lot for the community centre is dried out and then everything will have to be replaced at the same time. Double K was hired to complete the temporary fix.

**The Lagoon** is getting pumped down using irrigation. The pivot will be used all summer to bring liquid levels down.

Two summer students started work on May 2<sup>nd</sup>.

The new town skidsteer is on back order and should be available the 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> week of May. Bobcat Regina has offered a temporary machine to use fee of charge.
