### Highway One Corridor High School Plan

The Board of Education of Prairie Valley School Division would like to invite you to attend a public engagement/consultation meeting on March 20, 2012 beginning at 7 p.m. at Greenall High School in Balgonie.

The purpose of the meeting is to:

- Update the public on the status of High School Facility renewal plans within the Greenall Catchment Area;
- Present the results of the High School public survey completed in the spring of 2011; and
- Provide an opportunity to discuss the Highway One Corridor High School planning document.

The School Division is currently examining the construction of a new replacement regional high school or the modernization of Greenall High School with the construction of a second collegiate high school. The proposed options affect high school students in Emerald Park, White City, Pilot Butte, Balgonie, Kronau, Edenwold, McLean, St. Joseph's, the Hamlet of Lajord and surrounding areas.

The plan is being developed in response to projected population and enrolment growth within the Greenall High School catchment area. It examines a number of factors including educational programming, extra curricular activities, demographics, community preference, student safety and financial implications.

In the spring of 2011, the School Division surveyed area residents on their preferences for a new high school, and this fall completed a planning document analyzing the need for a new or replacement school.

The meeting will also provide those in attendance an opportunity to participate in small group discussions about the plan.

We encourage you to attend this meeting and assist the School Division in arriving at the best possible decision for Prairie Valley students.
