

EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT OPERATIONS COMMITTEE MEETING - Sept 14, 2010

Business:

Richard facilitated presentation for TransGas Pipeline – how and when to contact TransGas in the event of an emergency.

TransGas provided four attachments for the White City Emergency Response Plan:

- White City Maps – shows where pipelines are situated
- White City Map View – red area indicates “Area 6”: what TransGas considers our land location and what they would need to know in the event of a concern
- First Responders – Front Line Response: how to recognize a concern, what to do, what not to do
- Crossing Permit – form to complete by ANYONE who wishes to dig, build, or perform any type of work near a pipeline.

Debi will add these four attachments to Appendix C of the White City Emergency Response Plan

In the event of a TransGas emergency there is a 24hour emergency # to call. We will receive instruction from trained technicians on what to do.

If an evacuation is necessary it is likely only a small area within a few hundred meters of the leak will be necessary.

Future Business:

EMO committee decided to hold a few more presentations similar to this one so we may build the procedure list of the White City Emergency Response Plan.

Nov 16 – Foster will try to have the RCMP attend AND Stan will provide presentation on media/Communications procedures

Dec 1 – We will ask Bill if he can arrange for Dumur Industries to attend

Diane works with Red Cross. Diane will ask Red Cross for procedures on when/how to contact Red Cross. Diane will help us determine if Red Cross should come out for a presentation as well.

- Richard will book the Fire Hall
- Carrie will invite Council and Town Manager
