Re: Saskatchewan Infrastructure Growth Initiative – Recreation Pilot Program

The Ministry of Municipal Affairs is pleased to inform municipalities of the Saskatchewan Infrastructure Growth Initiative – Recreation Pilot Program (SIGI-Rec) for the 2011-12 fiscal year.

SIGI-Rec will provide municipalities with interest rate subsidies for up to five years on \$12.5 million of municipal borrowing. This pilot program will assist municipalities in developing recreational infrastructure to meet the demand associated with growth in the community and surrounding area.

A municipality may apply with respect to eligible projects for which they will incur costs associated with construction commencing on or after April 1, 2011. If some of the project costs are incurred prior to April 1, 2011, the municipality may still apply but the subsidy grant will exclude those costs. If the application is approved, borrowing must occur by September 30, 2011.

The deadline to submit applications under the SIGI-Rec Program is May 31, 2011.
