

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF WHITE CITY TO CONTROL THE OPERATION OF SNOWMOBILES WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF WHITE CITY.

THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF WHITE CITY, IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THIS BYLAW IS IN ADDITION TO THE CURRENT SNOWMOBILE ACT.
2. IN THIS BYLAW:
 - (A) "SNOWMOBILE" HAS THE MEANING ASCRIBED TO IT IN THE SNOWMOBILE ACT (R.S.S. 1978 c.S-52).
 - (B) "STREET" MEANS ANY STREET, OR LANE WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF WHITE CITY AND INCLUDES A PUBLIC HIGHWAY, WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF WHITE CITY.
3. (A) PURSUANT TO SECTION 21 OF THE SNOWMOBILE ACT, AND SUBJECT TO SUBSECTIONS 2, 3, AND 5 HEREOF, SNOWMOBILES MAY BE OPERATED ON THE UNTRAVELLED PORTION OF VILLAGE STREETS, OTHER THAN A PROVINCIAL HIGHWAY, FOR THE PURPOSE OF TRAVELLING FROM PRIVATELY OWNED PROPERTY TO THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE AND RETURN, USING THE MOST DIRECT ROUTE, FROM THE OWNER'S PRIVATELY OWNED PROPERTY.
 - (B) IT SHALL BE UNLAWFUL TO OPERATE A SNOWMOBILE IN THE VILLAGE BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 11:00 P.M. AND 7:00 A.M.
 - (C) NO SNOWMOBILE SHALL BE OPERATED AT ANY TIME ON THE VILLAGE OF WHITE CITY PUBLIC RESERVE LAND (PARKS) OR BUFFER STRIPS OR LANES.
 - (D) NO SNOWMOBILE SHALL BE OPERATED WITHIN THE VILLAGE AT THE SPEED IN EXCESS OF 20 KILOMETRES PER HOUR, OR IN AN UNSAFE SPEED OR MANNER.
 - (E) A SNOWMOBILE MAY BE OPERATED ON A HIGHWAY WITHIN THE VILLAGE LIMITS SOLELY FOR THE PURPOSE OF CROSSING THE HIGHWAY.
4. SUBJECT TO SECTION 128 OF THE URBAN MUNICIPALITY ACT, 1984, NO PERSON SHALL CREATE AN EXCESSIVE OR UNUSUAL NOISE IN THE OPERATION OF A SNOWMOBILE WITHIN THE VILLAGE WHETHER OR NOT THE NOISE IS CAUSED BY THE MECHANICAL STATE OF THE SNOWMOBILE OR THE MANNER IN WHICH THE SNOWMOBILE IS OPERATED AND WHETHER OR NOT IT IS STATIONARY OR MOVING AT THE TIME THE NOISE IS CREATED.



5. (A) ANY PERSON WHO CONTRAVENES THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 3 OF THIS BYLAW SHALL BE LIABLE TO THE PENALTIES PROVIDED IN SECTION 39 OF THE SNOWMOBILE ACT R.S.S. 1978 c.S-52, OR THE PENALTIES PROVIDED IN THE SUMMARY OFFENCES PROCEDURE ACT, REGULATIONS, OR IN THE VILLAGE BYLAWS OR \$50 FINE IF NONE IS PROVIDED.
- (B) ANY SNOWMOBILE BEING OPERATED IN BREACH OF THIS BYLAW, OR IF BEING OPERATED BY AN UNLICENSED OPERATOR OR IF THE SNOWMOBILE IS NOT LICENSED UNDER THE SNOWMOBILE ACT R.S.S 1978 c.S-52, THE SNOWMOBILE MAY BE SEIZED AND IMPOUNDED BY THE VILLAGE OF WHITE CITY. IMPOUNDING FEES WILL BE \$30 FOR FIRST IMPOUNDING, PLUS INCIDENTAL COSTS AND EXPENSES ARISING FROM THE IMPOUNDING, AND \$60 FOR SECOND IMPOUNDING INSTANCE INVOLVING THE SAME SNOWMOBILE. SUCH IMPOUNDING FEES SHALL BE IN ADDITION TO ANY FINE
- IN THE EVENT THE OWNER HAS NOT PAID ALL COSTS WITHIN 90 DAYS OF NOTICE THE VILLAGE WILL SELL THE SNOWMOBILE FOR POUNDAGE AND INCIDENTAL COSTS AT A PUBLIC AUCTION.
- IN THE EVENT THE OWNER IS ACQUITTED OF THE OFFENCE FOR BREACH OF BYLAW FOR WHICH THE SNOWMOBILE WAS IMPOUNDED, THE POUNDAGE FEES AND INCIDENTAL COSTS PAID BY THE OWNER WILL BE REFUNDED.
- (C) ANY PERSON CONVICTED OF A BREACH OF THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 4 OF THIS BYLAW SHALL BE LIABLE FOR A PENALTY AS PROVIDED IN THE GENERAL PENALTY BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF WHITE CITY.
- (D) THE OWNER OF A SNOWMOBILE IS LIABLE FOR THE BREACH OR CONTRAVENTION OF ANY PROVISIONS OF THIS BYLAW IN CONNECTION WITH THE OPERATION OF A SNOWMOBILE UNLESS THE OWNER PROVES AT THE TIME OF THE BREACH OR CONTRAVENTION THE SNOWMOBILE WAS NOT BEING OPERATED BY HIM NOR BY ANY OTHER PERSON WITH HIS CONSENT.
6. BYLAW NO. 129-91 IS HEREBY REPEALED.
7. THIS BYLAW TAKES EFFECT ON APPROVAL BY THE SASKATCHEWAN HIGHWAY TRAFFIC BOARD.

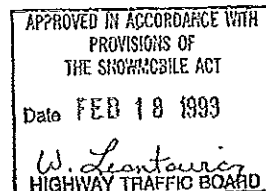

TOWN OF WHITE CITY

BYLAW NO. 471-06

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF WHITE CITY TO AMEND BYLAW NO. 152-93, RESPECTING TO CONTROL THE OPERATION OF SNOWMOBILES WITHIN THE TOWN OF WHITE CITY.

The Council of the Town of White City in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1. That Bylaw No. 152-93 be amended as follows:

In Section 5A), replace "\$50." with '200.', after the words 'bylaws or'

In Section 5B), replace "\$30." with '100.' before the words 'for the first impounding' and replace "\$80." with '\$200.' before the words 'for the second impounding'

- 2. That this Bylaw come into force upon third reading.
