Re: Town Foreman's Report

So far this winter, we have received a near record amount of snowfall for November. The Town Foreman and new employee have been able to keep up with the equipment that we have. However, some equipment is starting to become worn out. For example, the snow blower for the tractor needs constant attention: it is five years old. The town employees are maintaining and repairing the equipment as best as they can, however this means that there are times that we are waiting several days for parts. This is a risk to the town should we have to wait during a snow storm. As well, although the compound is a big help for storing our equipment, there is not enough room in the town shop to properly thaw out snow removal equipment.

Note that after the New Year, the Town Foreman's phone number will be 527-8510. The emergency phone number, 539-6179, will remain the same.

SaskWater has indicated that they have commissioned their new well to supply the Town with treated water.

As discussed at a Council Meeting, there is a used pivot for sale for \$21,000. The Town Manager has more information if necessary.

Decorative Christmas lights will be installed on light standards the second week of December.
