Re: 2011 Fire Protection Agreement

Background

The 2011 Fire Protection Agreement between the Town of White City and the RM of Edenwold was tabled at the November 22, 2010 meeting for the purpose of gathering more information.

The Towns of Pilot Butte and Balgonie both agreed to extend the agreements for 2011 at the same rates as 2010.

Discussion

In reviewing the 2010 agreement and discussing that agreement with the Administrator from the RM of Edenwold, it appears that the 2010 agreement was based on a \$50,000/year fee. The proposed 2011 agreement stated \$45,000 which was an oversight on the part of the RM of Edenwold when preparing the agreement.

Gail, Administrator of the RM of Edenwold, will be presenting the amended agreement to Council at their meeting on Tuesday December 7, 2010.

Budget Implications

None.

Conclusion

Since the proposed 2011 Fire Protection Agreement stated the fees payable to the Town of White City would be \$45,000, the RM Council will have to approve the change of fees to increase them to \$50,000.

The Fire fees were negotiated in 2010 to be \$50,000/year. The 2011 agreement should have a remuneration of nothing less than \$50,000.
