Re: Foreman's Report

Recycle Bins- I spoke with Tim Graham late last week regarding the possibility of moving both bins behind the post office. He spoke positive about the idea but addressed that he has to add another 1800sq. ft. to the building for Canada Post. Tim would like to meet with me this week to discuss possible options.

Ball Diamonds- The water line has been trenched in for the irrigation system from Sask. Water. This week we will trench in the potable water line as well the line for the irrigation system for diamond #3

Water Treatment Plant- All tenders are in for the required work. Shauna will contact the lowest tender and this work should commence soon.

Streets- The condition for White City Dr. beside Dumar has improved. Lott Road has one bad spot. I will speak with Ben K. to see what contractor is repairing his roads to provide a quote to dig out and pave these two areas.
I have started street sweeping. All streets should be completed later this week weather permitting.

Lagoon- The level is slowly receding. Keeping the pivot moving has been a issue due to the soft wet ground in the field. I will start filling in the ruts this week with soil and wood chips. This will provide a firm base for the wheels to follow.

Leaf Pick Up & Tree Chipping-Leaf pick up will continue this week if necessary. We will begin tree chipping next week. I will use the chips out at the pivot.

Summer Students- All three students are now working

Equipment- All attachments for the Bobcat have been picked up. We will continue to use there loaner machine for the time. Our unit is expected to arrive in June. Bobcat is behind production due to the tsunami in Japan earlier this year.
