Re: White Butte Sub-Committees

### **Background**

The White Butte Regional Planning Committee is composed of representatives from the Town of Pilot Butte, Town of Balgonie, Town of White City, the Village of Edenwold and the RM of Edenwold. The mandate of the White Butte Regional Committee is to work together on regional issues. The projects that the White Butte Committee has been working on are the Highway No. 1 East Study and the White Butte Regional Fire Committee.

### **Discussion**

The Regional group is creating two new sub-committees, one for Education and one for Recreation. The mandate of each committee has not been established as of yet. However the education committee will most likely be involved with the discussion of the new High School and the Recreation Committee will probably be tasked with evaluating the recreational facilities in the region and identifying the needs of the region. Each member municipality has been tasked with appointing one member of Council to each of these sub-committees.
