**1. Minutes from April meeting: accepted**

**2. Playgrounds**

Work will be start on Thursday, May 26, all day Friday, May 27 and likely all day May 28. Arlene estimates 10 people for the Splash Park site, 10 for Fernwood, and 4 for the swings. Kyla has rounded up several people in her neighbourhood to assist with Fernwood.

*ACTION:* All make phone calls and/or email contacts now to request volunteer assistance. Volunteers should contact Arlene if interested.

*ACTION:* Arlene will talk to Shauna about potentially putting Splash Park sign up at the same time.

*ACTION:* Kara will put a sign at the Playschool to ask for volunteers.

**3. Garage Sale**

Bags with balloons, garage sale do's and don't sheets are available at the library and Town office. Maps will be at Okay Dokey's, Cocobeans, Emerald Park Convenience, and Subway for pickup.

**4. Mobile Playground**

Rebecca Bruce cannot run it this year, but her sister will do it – no training is necessary, as per Arlene. It will run the first week in July after the long weekend. Arlene is waiting for funding approval. Mobile playground will run from 9:30-3:30. Arlene is still looking into other options than the Community Centre for Friday.

*ACTION:* Arlene will put the notice in the newsletter for June.

**5. Community Directory**

Arlene is still collecting ads. Natalie reported she has about 270 submissions. The stuffers asking for updates to the community directory will be mailed to all residents. The directory is to be printed by the end of June.

*ACTION:* Arlene will submit all ads to Kim at Western Litho by May 20.

*ACTION:* Natalie will submit the information to Dale via Excel spreadsheet.

**6. Skatepark**

Rosann talked to Shauna Bzdel and the Town is hoping to approve \$100K for this park. The RM could be approached to match funding.

Locations for the skatepark and BMX park were discussed. One thought was to locate east of the post office and relocate current play structure. Polling of neighbours would have to be done. This site would likely be the farthest away from homes. The adult traffic going by would be a perk.

A Greenall student submitted an idea regarding the BMX site – he should be kept in the loop if it's a go ahead. We thought we should concentrate first on the skatepark as that has been our priority.

A committee is to be formed that includes students to look at configurations and specs. Once research, specifications, land area, and as much detail as can be provided is complete – Rosann offered to write up a formal proposal to be submitted to the Town. (Proposal should include things like fencing options, liability, specs, type of equipment, bikes and boards allowed?) Rosann, Ray Schmuland, and Lana Lafontaine volunteered to sit on this committee. Students will be contacted. Committee will meet several times for an hour to show kids designs and narrow down what they would like and/or what will work.

*ACTION:* Rosann will contact the City of Regina to ask about specs of some of their skate parks.

*ACTION:* Rob will contact Pilot Butte regarding their skatepark.

*ACTION:* Lana will check out Edmonton's skatepark info.

## **7. Newsletter Editor**

Rosann received an email from a Gr. 11 student in Greenall who is really interested in becoming the volunteer editor and serving community. All agreed with her taking the position.

*ACTION:* Rosann will meet with her and maybe Dale and Kim in a couple weeks to see what she will do.

## **8. Concerns/Miscellaneous**

Rob brought up the idea that something should be done with the area near Federal Drive where a playground was torn out. It is not attractive.

## **9. Committee Reports**
