Happening around town:

- New pavement at Bower West Phase 1.
- Skateboard pad is being used by many residents.
- Ball Park – Number two ball diamond has topsoil installed; remainder of work to be completed in the spring.
- Walking trail on White City Drive has been completed. Additional walking trail installed from Christopher Place to Emerald Gate East.

The Town has hired a new Operations Technician, Robert Mitchell.

The drainage channel at Emerald Ridge Park has a build-up of silt, which is to be cleaned out in the new year.

Crack sealing was not completed this year due to the lack of manpower and cold weather.

Leaf pick-up will continue until the first snowfall.

All Town snow clearing equipment has been serviced and is ready to go.

The Town purchased a new snow blower for the TV 140 bi-directional tractor. It was purchased from Markusson New Holland.

All the irrigation lines in Town parks have been blown out in preparation for winter.
