Re: Foreman's Report

- The walking trail lights on Confederation Drive, Federal Drive and Fernwood Street will be up and lit by December 23, 2011.
- There have been a few issues with snow clearing equipment. These have been resolved.
- Bower West culverts need maintenance due to excess silt; they will be "hydrovac'd" by the developer.
- The Town Foreman will be getting pavement quotes for Gregory Avenue E past Deneve Road. The Community Centre parking lot and Ramm Avenue East will be measured and put to tender.
- Due to the expansion of the Town of White City, including new subdivisions and population which require more equipment to maintain, the Town is in need of a larger Town Maintenance Shop and compound facilities.
- The Town Foreman will check into more decorative garbage cans for the walking trails throughout White City. This item is to be included in the 2012 budget.
- Recycling bins to be relocated to the area beside the ball park concession stand because of the availability of night time lighting.
- Due to construction on the southbound lane of Highway 48, the information sign has been damaged beyond repair. The Department of Highways will order a new one. The expected arrival is 4-6 weeks.
